Act. 2.2. Training Modules

Main objective of this Training Module:

The training module will cover in more detail relevant aspects specifically in relation to IP protection in agricultural products, and will focus, at a more advanced level, upon specific aspects of geographical indications, traditional knowledge and related issues of patent/plant variety protection. In addition, attendants will be familiarised with basic issues concerning the interface between IP and competition and will be introduced to the foundations of international jurisdiction and applicable law aspects in relation to, predominantly, IP licenses, which will serve as a precursor session to more detailed coverage of cross border IP licensing and technology transfer agreements to be conducted during the third meeting.

Expected Results:

Participants will, first, acquire a more detailed understanding of the laws and policies underlying specifically the laws of geographical indications and related rights with regards to agricultural products and will also gain a sound understanding of the impact of rules under competition and conflicts of laws.
